**Brief Outline of the AGM Format**

District 26 is comprised of three Bargaining Units: Teacher Bargaining Unit, Occasional Teacher Bargaining Unit, and the Professional Student Services Personnel (PSSP) Bargaining Unit. In each of the Bargaining Unit meetings, motions to amend the governing constitution can be made. As well, each elected officer reports the affairs of the Bargaining Unit during the current school year. Questions may be asked of the elected officers. The District meeting follows, with much the same format as the Bargaining Unit meetings. Candidates seeking elected Executive positions have an opportunity to make speeches in each of the meetings.

Dinner with wine is served following these meetings. The evening is concluded with the presentation of awards to members who have made significant contributions in various areas. Both District (*Gordie Award, Marjorie Laphen Award, Branch Representative Award, Rhonda Kimberley-Young Award, New Member Award, Volunteer Recognition Plaques*) and Provincial Awards (*Award of Merit, Honorary Membership, Provincial Educational Services Certificate*) are presented. Nominations for the District awards are due no later than **April 21, 2010**.
